June

Marching Band registration form: students will receive a marching band registration form from their middle school band director, or take one tonight. This should be completed and turned in **by June 6th along with the fall marching fee**. This form reserves the student's position in the marching band.

July

Keep playing your instrument and enjoy summer! Schedule any instrument repairs to be completed prior to band camp.

August

High School Registration: Date (check the OCHS website/calendar)

- 1) Fall marching fee - \$175 (if not already paid) & marching tshirt/sweatshirt (~\$40)
- 2) ASB fee - \$20
- 3) Concert Band: No fee – but will need to order Concert attire for student
*if transfer student – different band class and may have fee (see course handbook)
- 4) Jazz Band fee: \$50 – (Early Bird class) + Concert attire for student

Marching Band Camp: August 22 – 26th

- Daily 9-4 at OCHS. This week is required if you are signing up for marching band.
- Lunch break – bring lunch and lots of water, wear comfortable shoes & clothes
- Registration on August 22
- Marching uniform fitting & distribution. This is where you will order marching shoes/tshirt/sweatshirt for year.
- Aug. 26th we will go longer as we will be playing for the football jamboree & then will have a fun event for students in the evening.

September

FUNDRAISER: Pete's Cruise-In: September 3

- Students will be given the opportunity to volunteer for this event during band camp
- Parents may volunteer, credit goes to their student's account
- Marching band will perform during the event

Concert Dress Measurement/Order

- Form available online and in band class in September.
- Turn in form to Band Director with stapled receipt of payment from accounting.
